BP Refining sign 3 year contract with ATMECO for leak risk management services

BP Refining have entered into a 3 year agreement for ATMECO to provide leak risk management systems and services, and a range of other monitoring support services to the BP Bulwer Refinery in Brisbane, Queensland.

The contract involves implementation of the ATMECO Component Integrity Management System (CIMS) to detect and assist remediate hydrocarbon leaks within the Bulwer Refinery, and a range of other activities assisting risk management and environmental performance.
